
Anglican Chant

This chant can be used in many ways in liturgical church services. It was originally written as a way to sing the Psalms during Lent. It could also be used for singing any part of the service including the Sanctus, Agnus Dei, or the Lord's Prayer. The area above and below the music has been left blank for you to add your own lyrics and title. Use a | to indicate measure changes within the text. All syllables of any given word, except the last, are sung on the 1st (or only) notes in the measure.

Use a: to indicate the start of the 2nd part after the double bar line. The optional ending could be used for an "Amen." The chant could also be used in educational settings as sight reading practice — using any words you care to insert.
